#### Methodology

##### ■ Field research

The use of services such as Factiva and the Internet allows us to regularly monitor more than 8,000 publications for up-to-date information.

#### Magazines and publications

All officially published data as well as production and market information is analysed and checked for detail and reliability.

#### Other sources

Close relationships are maintained with national and international organisations, such as government institutions and trade associations.
